Program:

This workshop will convene NIDA diversity supplement recipients for two days in a setting, which will enable them to interact with NIDA program staff and select NIDA funded investigators. The workshop's goals are to: (1) foster the mentorship of diversity supplement recipients by ensuring they are brought in the NIDA niche, connected with NIDA PO's and fully exposed to career advancement opportunities (including training and funding) and; (2) support the research development of recipients by introducing the recipients to NIDA's research priorities and the current state of science, providing them with an opportunity to present their research during a poster session and attend break-out sessions by areas of interest. Ultimately, we would like open lines of communication in place between diversity supplement recipients and their respective program officials. Establishing such an environment for the recipients will aid them as they advance in their career and strive to become independent funded NIDA investigators.
